## About Us

Our Mission Statement is: **"Sharing the enjoyment of live music and encouraging Australian talent."**

The Wyvern Music Club is a not-for-profit organisation affiliated with the Federated Music Clubs of Australia NSW Council Inc.

Wyvern Music Club was first established in 1953 as Newington College Music Group, an offshoot of the Parents and Friends' Association of Newington College at Stanmore. It was affiliated with The Federated Music Clubs of Australia which had formed in 1928. In January, 1976 Newington College Music Group changed its name to "Wyvern Music Club-Lindfield" and would hold four "musicales" a year at Newington Preparatory School, Lindfield and one annual concert at Willoughby Town Hall combined with four other Music Clubs (Lane Cove, Manly, Mosman and Roseville). The Wyvern name came from the wyvern symbol in the Newington School logo.

In 2004, the decision was taken by the Club members to relocate the concerts to Forestville to meet the needs of classical music-lovers in this area.
